ORDER

This is the second application filed by the applicant under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail relating to FIR/Crime No.642/2024 registered at Police Station Jamodhi Sidhi, District Sidhi, for the offence punishable under Sections 137(2), 74, 308(2), 107, 61(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Sections 7, 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012. The applicant is in jail since 11.10.2024.

2. The applicant's earlier bail application was rejected vide order dated 07.03.2025 passed in M.Cr.C. No.5729 of 2025.

3. Learned Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of the applicant has submitted that the applicant is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the



case. It is submitted that in a similar circumstance, the coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 26.03.2025 passed in M.Cr.C. No.11343 of 2025 [Pankaj Pandey @ Pankaj Gautam Vs. The State of Madhya Pradesh] has enlarged the co-accused person on bail, hence, to maintain parity, the present applicant be also enlarged on bail.

4. Learned Panel Lawyer has opposed the bail application and has submitted that no case of bail is made out.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and to maintain parity, this Court is inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Thus, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the application is allowed.

6. It is directed that **applicant - Abhay @ Tinkal Singh** shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (**Rupees Fifty Thousand Only**) with one solvent surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned for his appearance before the said Court on all such dates as may be fixed by that Court in this regard during pendency of trial.

7. It is further directed that the applicant shall comply with the provisions of Section 480(3) of BNSS.

8. Accordingly, Misc. Criminal Case stands disposed of.
