ORDER

This is the first application filed by the applicants under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Crime No.914/2025 registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Sidhi (M.P.) for the offence punishable under Sections 103(1), 296, 109, 115(2), 118(1), 333, 351(3) and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the case. It is submitted that the applicant has not been named in the FIR and he has been made accused on the basis of memorandum and subsequent statements of the prosecution witnesses. Co-accused persons Trilok and Jagdev Saket have already been



granted bail by this Court vide orders dated 08.12.2025 and 18.11.2025 passed in M.Cr.C.No.57269/2025 and M.Cr.C.No.53656/2025 respectively and the case of this applicant is not different from them, hence, the applicant be granted the benefit of anticipatory bail.

3. Learned counsel for the State has opposed the bail application and has submitted that the applicant was involved in the offence, hence, he is not entitled to be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

4. Heard the parties and perused the case diary.

5. Looking to the factual aspect of the case and the previous orders of this Court and the trial Court, this Court deems it fit to enlarge the applicant on anticipatory bail. Hence, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the application is **allowed**.

6. It is directed that in the event of arrest the applicant shall be enlarged on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of **Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only)** with one solvent surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer for their appearance before him during the course of investigation or before the trial Court concerned during trial, as the case may be.

7. The applicant is directed to cooperate with the investigating agency and also appear on the date and time directed by the Investigating Officer.

8. The applicant shall not directly or indirectly induce or threaten any prosecution witness.

9. The applicant will regularly appear before the trial Court and cooperate till disposal of this case.



10. It is further directed that the applicants shall abide by all the conditions as enumerated under Section 482(2) of BNSS.

11. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of.
