ORDER

This first application under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita has been filed on behalf of the applicant for grant of anticipatory bail.

2. Applicant is apprehending her arrest in connection with Crime No.409 of 2025 of Police Station-Churhata, District-Rewa (MP) for commission of the offences punishable under Sections 85, 80(2) of BNS and sections 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. Prosecution story in brief is that applicant along with co-accused persons continuously harassed deceased and on account of the same, deceased committed suicide

4. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant is sister-in-law of deceased. It is urged that applicant is a lady. It is also urged that deceased committed suicide in her parental house. Further, it is also urged that prior to the incident, deceased's husband had lodged a report to the effect that since last 6 days, deceased is missing. Further, in suicide note also, no specific allegations have been leveled against the present applicant. In suicide note, no demand of



dowry etc. has been mentioned. On above grounds, it is urged that applicant be granted benefit of anticipatory bail.

5. Learned Government Advocate for the respondent/State on the other hand has opposed the application.

6. Having regard to relationship of deceased with applicant and other evidence available on record, I deem it proper to grant benefit of anticipatory bail to the applicant.

7. It is directed that in the event of her arrest, applicant be released on bail on her furnishing a personal bond of **Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand Only)** with one solvent surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. It is also directed that the applicant shall abide by the conditions as enumerated under Section 482 (2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

8. It is made clear that applicant shall appear before the Investigating Officer as & when she is so directed and co-operate with the investigation and he shall also appear before the Trial Court failing which his bail shall automatically stand cancelled without further reference to the Court.
